Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT)

The Families First Coronavirus Response Act includes a benefit called Pandemic-EBT (P-EBT) for children who received free or reduced-price school meals in the 2019-2020 school year, but their school is was closed.

Who needs to apply for P-EBT?

If your family is currently receiving SNAP, you may not need to apply for P-EBT. We will make every attempt to match our SNAP records with information provided in the Department of Education (DOE) files. If we can match your child exactly, that child's benefits will automatically be added to your existing SNAP card. If we cannot exactly match your child between the SNAP records and the DOE records, see information on how to claim the P-EBT benefit for other children in your home in question and answer 4.1 below.

Everyone else must apply to get P-EBT benefits.

Complete the entire application to see if your child is eligible. Answering all questions will help us process your application more quickly.

Applications will be processed in the order they are received. The P-EBT amount for *each eligible child* is **\$256.50**.
